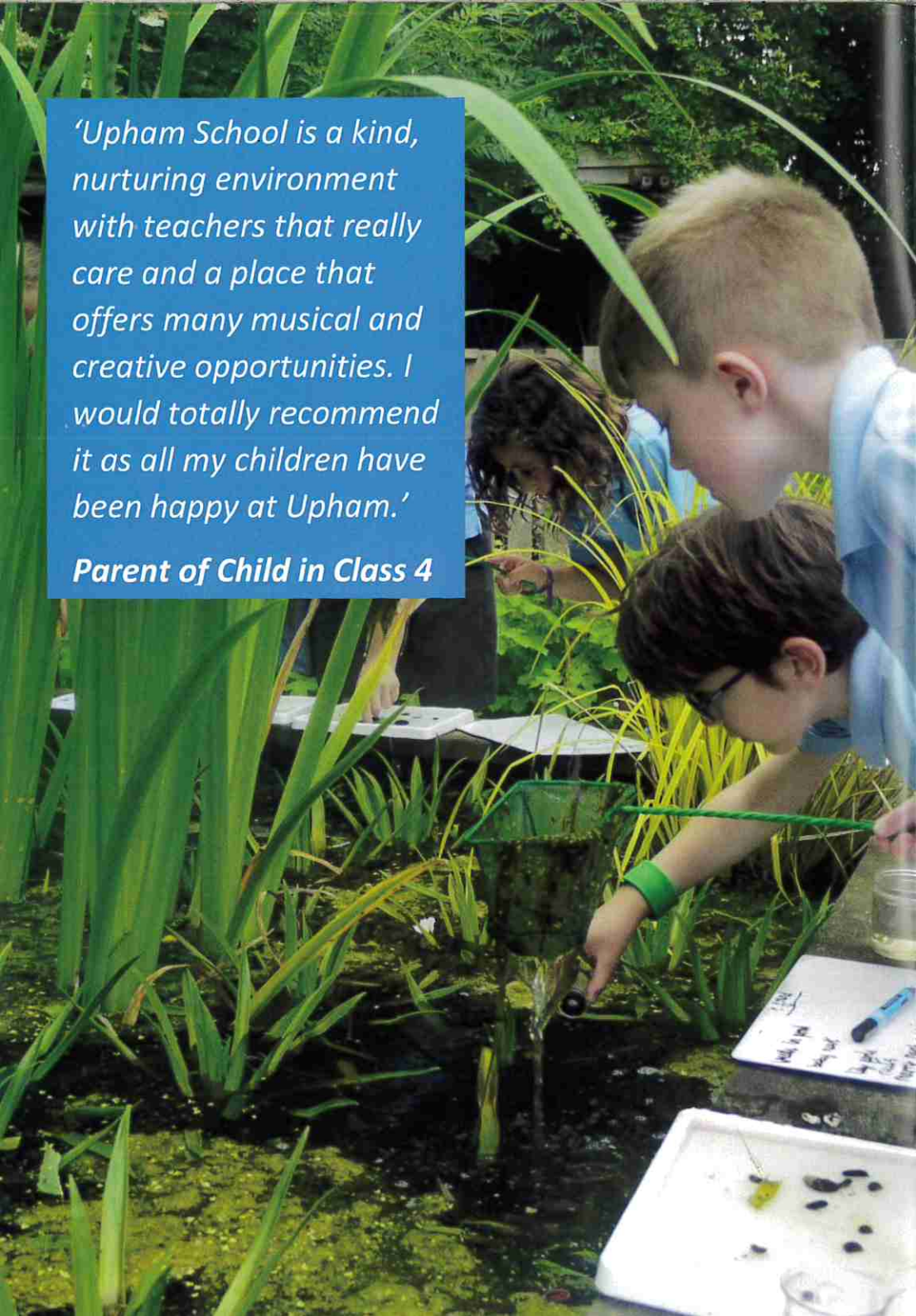
Our Vision For Our School

The Arts & Sport



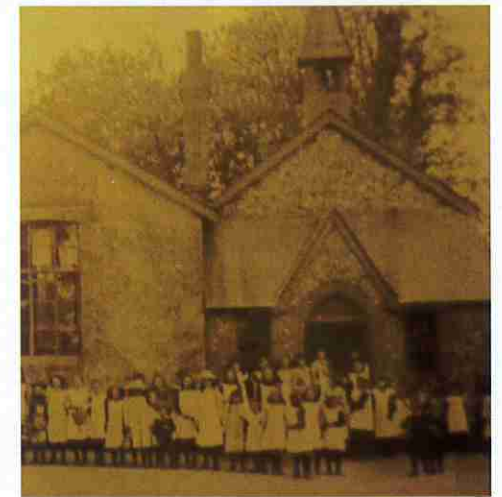
We believe that engagement in sports and in The Arts (ie dance, music, drama and visual arts) is essential for every child at Upham School.


Spiritual development is nurtured at Upham, alongside other development ('mind, body and spirit').

We partner new Class 1 children with older 'buddies' from Class 4.


These positive role models help build confidence in our youngest children as they take their first steps on their learning journey.
