

Friday maths YELLOW ANSWERS

Biscuits are put into boxes of 10. How many boxes can be made with 70 biscuits? 7 boxes

$$70 \div 10 = 7$$

In a class there are 32 children. 17 are boys. How many girls are there?

$$\begin{array}{r} 32 \\ - 17 \\ \hline 15 \end{array}$$

15 girls

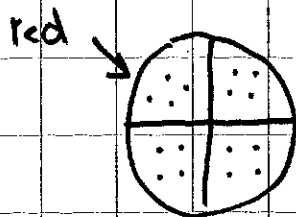
Don reads 5 pages of his book a day. How many pages does he read in a week?

$$7 \times 5 = 35$$

He reads 35 pages

Freddie has 16 marbles. One quarter are red, the rest are blue. How many blue marbles does he have?

$$16 \div 4 = 4$$



$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

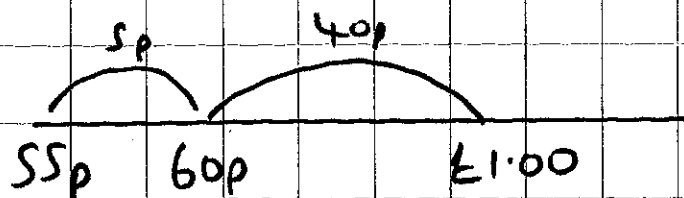
12 are blue

A lesson starts at a quarter past 9. It lasts for half an hour. What time does it end?

9.45 or quarter to 10

Sarah buys an orange for 25p and a banana for 30p. How much change does she get from £1.00?

$$30p + 25p = 55p$$



She gets 45p change.
