

Friday maths GREEN *Answers*

Biscuits are put into boxes of 6. How many boxes can be made with 42 biscuits?

7 boxes can be made.

$$42 \div 6 = 7$$

In a school there are 332 children. 174 are boys. How many girls are there?

$$\begin{array}{r} 332 \\ - 174 \\ \hline 158 \end{array}$$

158 girls

Don reads 5 pages of his book a day on week days and 24 pages a day at the weekend. How many pages does he read in a week?

he reads 73 pages

$$5 \times 5 = 25$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 24 \\ \times 2 \\ \hline 48 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 48 \\ + 25 \\ \hline 73 \end{array}$$

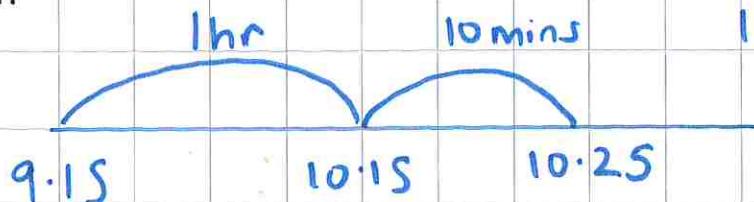
Freddie has 76 marbles. One quarter are red, the rest are blue. How many blue marbles does he have?

57 are blue

$$4 \overline{) 76}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 19 \\ \times 3 \\ \hline 57 \\ 2 \end{array}$$

A lesson starts at a quarter past 9. It lasts for 1 hour 10 minutes. What time does it end?



10:25 or 25 minutes past 10

Sarah buys 2 oranges for 52p and 3 bananas for 30p. How much change does she get from £5.00?

£3.06 change.

$$\begin{array}{r} 52 \\ \times 2 \\ \hline 104p \end{array}$$

$$30p \times 3 = 90p$$

$$104 + 90 = 194p$$
