

This afternoon for your topic task, you will be making your very own Ancient Greek theatre!

### To make a Greek theatre

#### YOU WILL NEED:

Cereal boxes

Cardboard tube/s

Sellotape/masking tape/glue/stapler  
(you may not need all of these)

Writing pencil

Extra cardboard for seating area

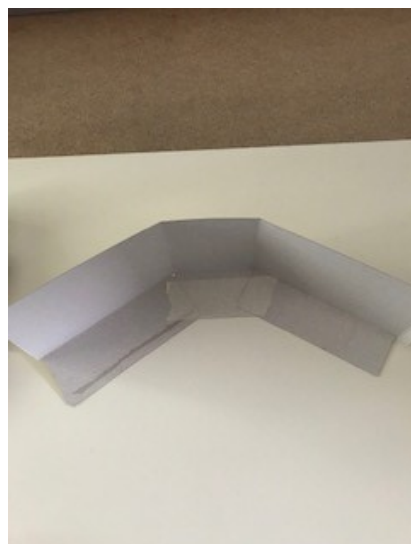
Scissors/craft knife

*I also had a thicker cardboard box from a parcel delivery which was very useful for the tiered seating.*

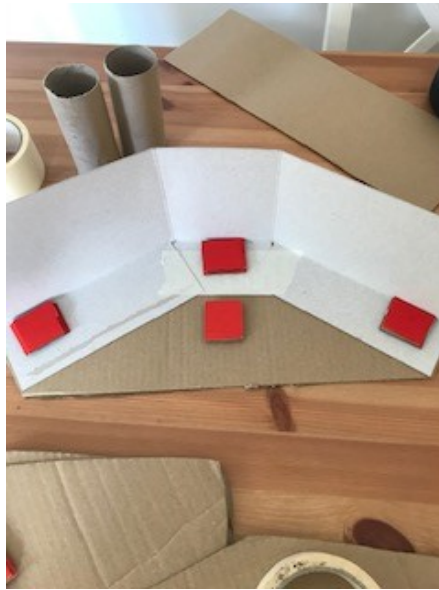
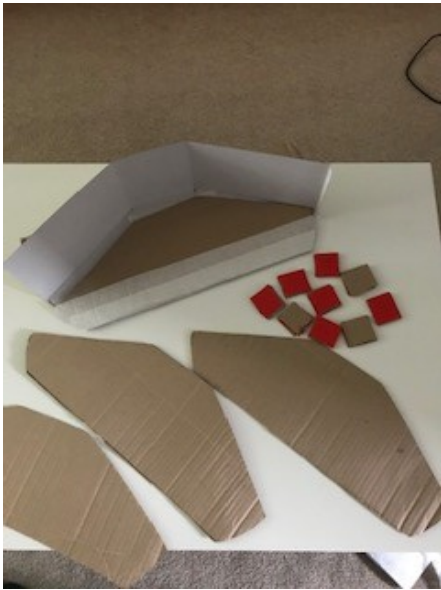


#### METHOD

1. Completely open out larger cereal box. Cut off the flaps from one side.
2. Then, cut the box in half on the long side.
3. Stick masking tape to the base flaps to make a vaguely curved shape.
4. Next, make some wedges to hold your seating area up.
5. As I used a flimsy cereal box, I put the back on a thicker cardboard base to help it to stand up.



6. I used the base shape as a template for the seating areas. You will need to trim a bit off the front each time to get a tiered seating effect. I cut out 4 layers but you could do 3.
7. I used masking tape on the front edges of the seating areas to tidy up the cut edges but also so I could draw a stone pattern.
8. As you can see from the photo, I used 4 wedges for the base layer to add stability.
9. I added masking tape to the platform and back wall to hold everything together.



10. Repeat until you get to the top platform. I covered this entirely in masking tape to create a stone effect all over.
11. If you would like, you can add a stone pillar (toilet roll tubes) either side of the platform.
12. Keep safe until next week.
