

1. a) The largest school is Westgate.
The smallest school is The Kings School.

$$\begin{array}{r} 13\cancel{5}0 \\ - 208 \\ \hline 1142 \end{array}$$

The difference between the two schools is 1142 pupils.

2. a) I cycle to Wyvern and Kings.

$$144 + 72 = 216$$

So the cost is £2.16.

d) $3.2 \times 6 = 19.2$ It would take me 19.2 minutes to cycle to Kings.

e) $2.8 \times 10 = 28$. It would take me 28 minutes to run to Wyrem.

f) $13.8 \div 2 = 6.9$ The journey was to Greggs School.
