

What day-to-day routines feel like in Class 3

8.55am – 9.05am	Registration time – children complete a practical quick English or Maths task such as times tables, a written calculation, a ‘spot the mistake sentence’
9.05am-10.10am	Often Maths. Start of lesson is a warm up/ practice (times tables, Beat-It, Learn-It, or arithmetic) Then the focussed Maths lesson.
10.10am – 10.30am	Assembly in the hall
10.30am – 11am	Playtime Outside
11am – 12.15pm	Often an English session – either with a spelling, grammar (often called SPAG), reading or writing focus – sometimes areas are together, sometimes more separate. Say a grace in class together before going into the hall.
12.15pm – 1.15pm	Lunchtime, everyone in the hall to eat together. By about 12.35pm everyone has finished and all go outside for playtime.
1.15pm – 2.20pm	Children often start the afternoon by quickly completing any corrections from work from the morning which has been marked (they call this ‘think pinks to do’). A topic session related to the area of study so could be RE, History, PE, Music etc
2.20pm – 2.40pm	Outside playtime
2.40pm – 3.30pm	A topic session – could be a continuation of that stated earlier or something completely different
