

Have a look at the questions below. One answer has already been given—how could you use this fact to work out the answers to the other questions? Can you explain how you worked them out?

I know... so...

$$\begin{aligned}\frac{3}{5} \times 4 &= \boxed{2} \frac{\boxed{2}}{\boxed{5}} \\ \frac{3}{5} \times 6 &= 3 \frac{3}{5} \\ \frac{3}{5} \times 7 &= \boxed{4} \frac{\boxed{1}}{\boxed{5}}\end{aligned}$$

$\nearrow - \frac{6}{5}$

$\downarrow + \frac{3}{5}$
