

What day-to-day routines feel like in Class 2

8.55am – 9.05am	Registration time – children complete a simple quick English or Maths task such as completing some number bonds, handwriting practice or reading a book
9.05am – 9.30am	A phonics session
9.30am – 10.10am	An English session
10.10am – 10.30am	Assembly in the hall
10.30am – 11am	Playtime Outside
11am – 12.00pm	A Maths session. Often starts with practising some tables such as 2x and 5x
12.15pm – 1.15pm	Lunchtime, Class 2 and 1 lead into the hall and stand behind their chairs. They say a grace together (or sing one) and everyone sits down together. Children from Classes 3 and 4 join them at 12.15pm. By about 12.35pm everyone has finished and all go outside for playtime.
1.15pm – 2.20pm	A topic session related to the area of study so could be RE, History, PE, Music etc
2.20pm – 2.40pm	Outside playtime
2.40pm – 3.30pm	Reading focussed activities. Teachers rotate around groups on different days so that each group gets a focussed session with the teacher and LSA. Children will also complete more independent reading activities to apply their skills.

The day often ends with a shared story together.
