The focus of this week's spelling rule

**Suffixes**

**Words ending in 'y' - swap the 'y' for an 'i' when you add the suffix 'ed'.**

**Words ending in 'e', drop the 'e' when you add 'ing'**

**Spelling sentences**

Your child should choose one of the following sentences to practise writing with capital letters and punctuation. You will see that they vary in difficulty and they can choose the one they feel most happy to write. They will be asked to write the sentence next Friday. They *do not* need to remember the sentence; we will slowly repeat it lots of times as part of their dictation work.

**The kitten kept hiding as it was scared.**

**Carefully, I carried the kitten as it was scared and shaking.**
