**Year 2 home learning.**

We are sending home a copy of the words we have been learning to spell. If your child would like to read and spell some of the words with you then extra practise is always beneficial but it is by no means an obligation.

The focus of this week's spelling rule is;

***Why do some words end in k or ck?***

**Use ck at the end of a word after a short vowel sound e.g. duck, brick**

***Why do some words end in ch or tch?***

**Use tch at the end of word after a short vowel sound e.g. catch, snatch.**

### **Spelling sentences**

Your child must choose one of the following sentences to write. You will see that they vary in difficulty and they can choose the one they feel most comfortable writing. Please encourage your child to read, say and write their chosen sentence, remembering to use capital letters and punctuation at the end of the sentence. They will be asked to write it next Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2025. They *do not* need to remember the sentence; we will repeat it slowly many times.
