In autumn, many people celebrate a good harvest with a harvest festival. Write a list of some of the foods that farmers grow on their land.



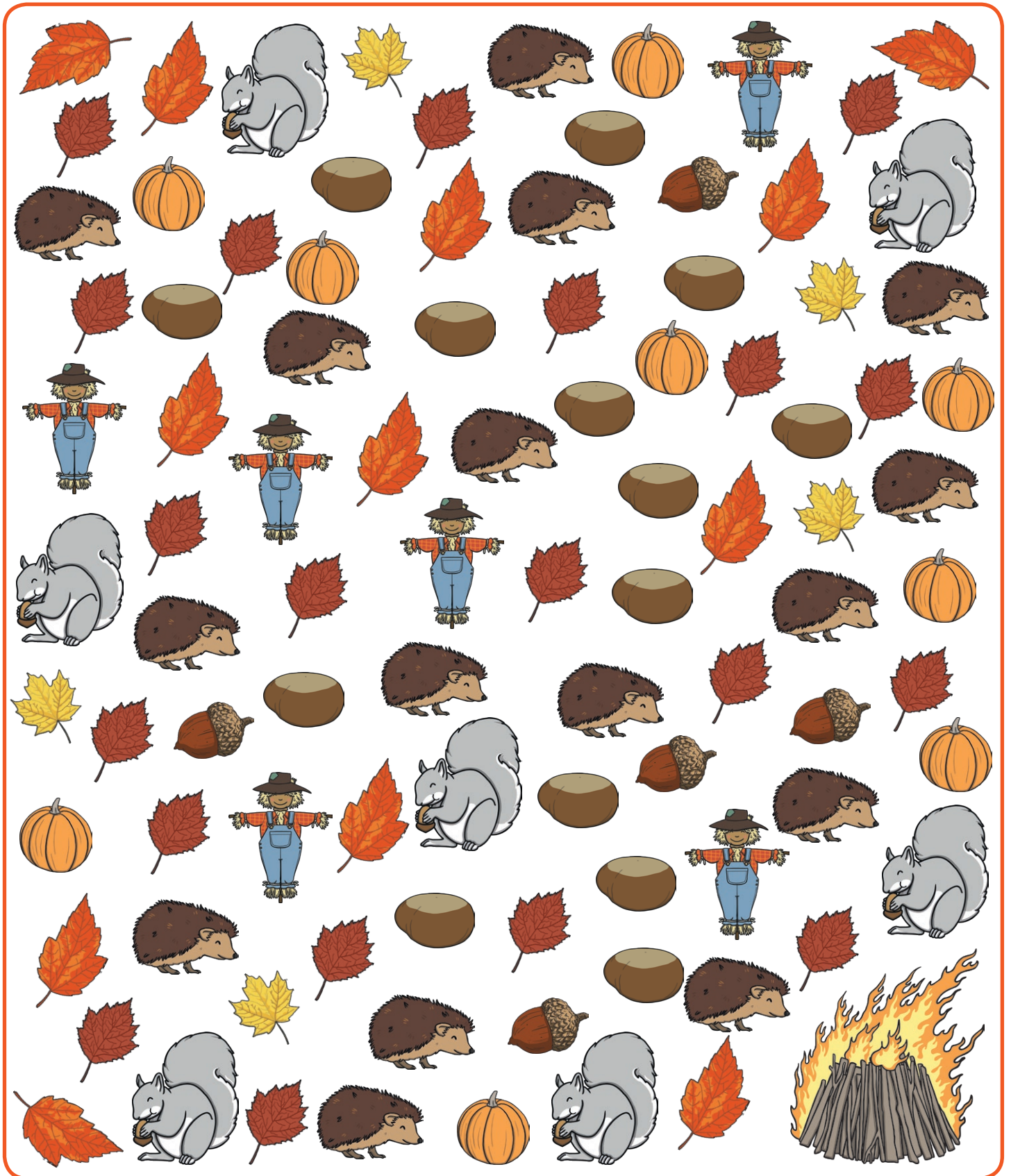
