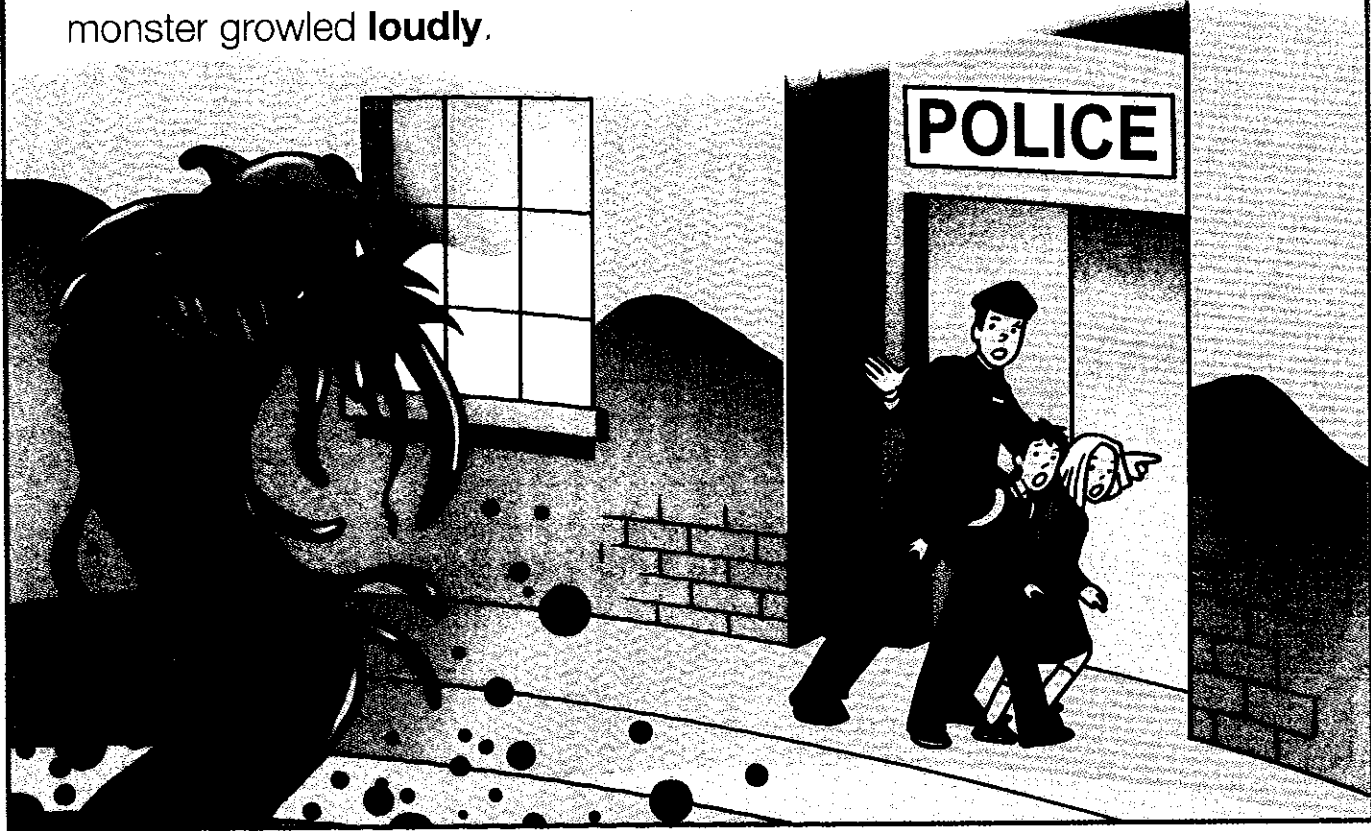


# Spelling

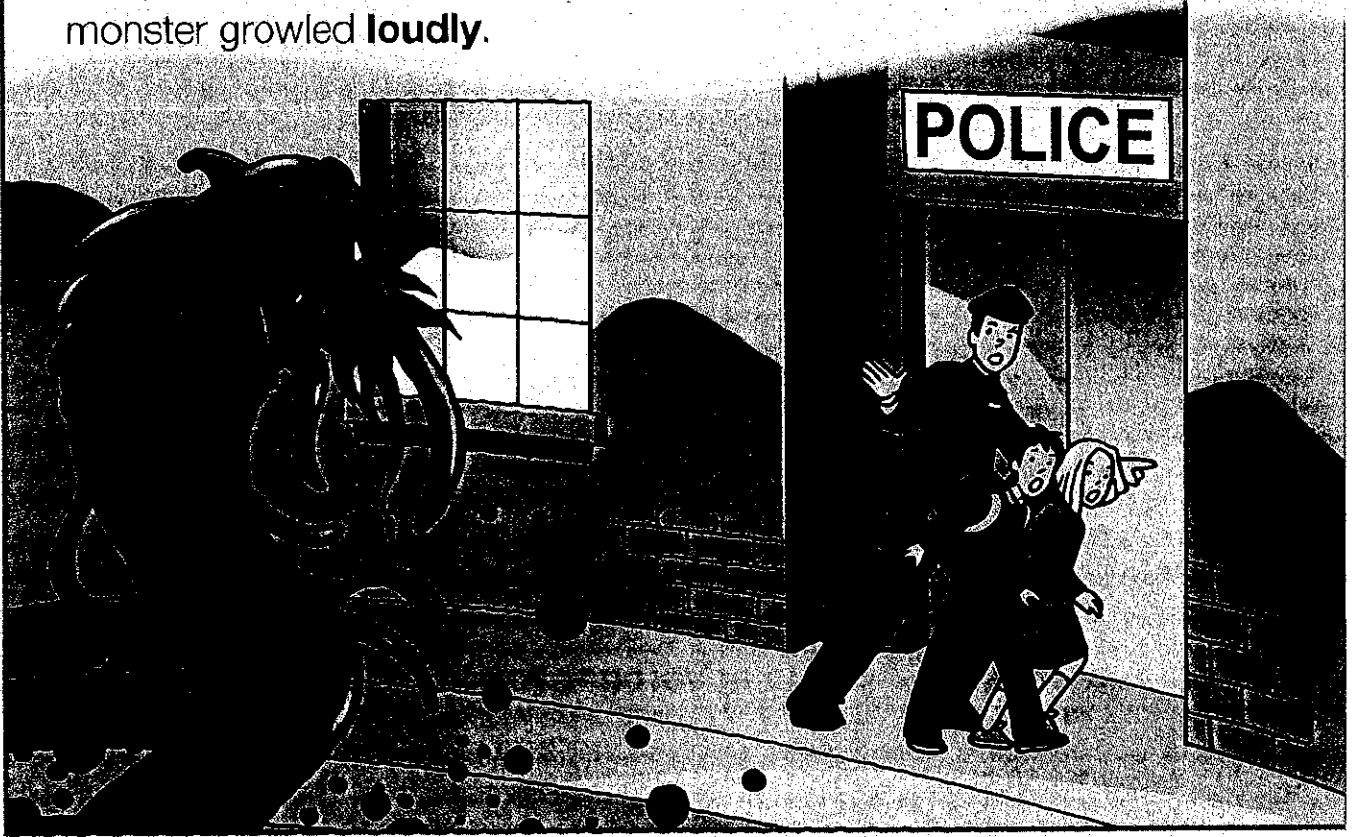
