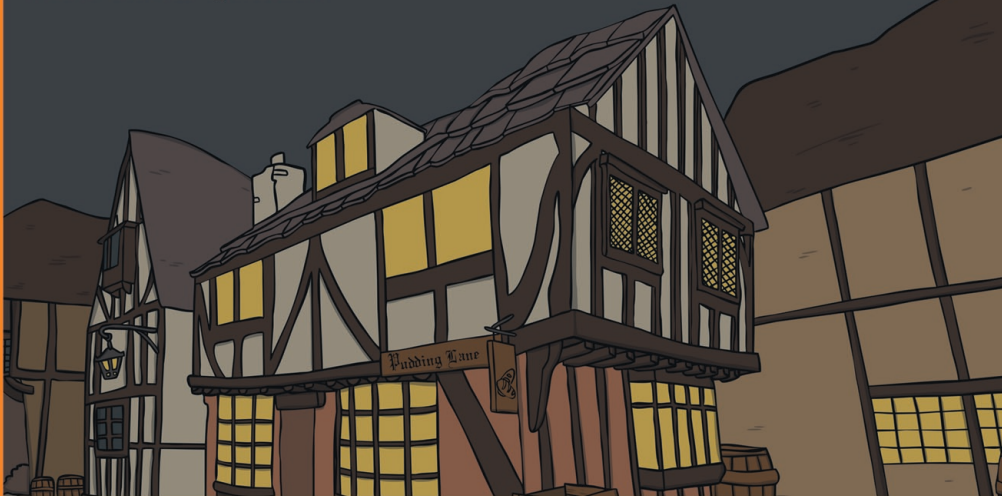

The Great Fire of London happened between the 2nd and 5th September 1666.



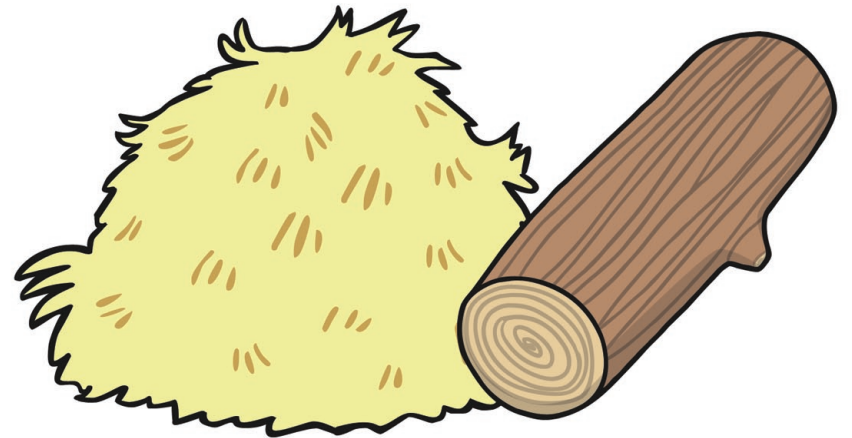
The Great Fire of London

The fire lasted four days, and burned down over 13 000 homes.

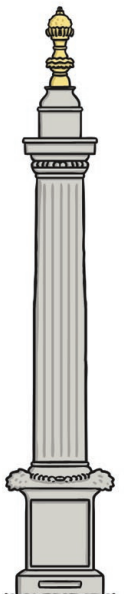
The Great Fire of London
