

Verbs: past and present tense 1

Remember

Verbs are doing words. Verbs can be in the **past tense** or the **present tense**. The tense of the verb shows when it happened.

I **open** the door. (present tense – happening now)

I **opened** the door. (past tense – happened in the past)
