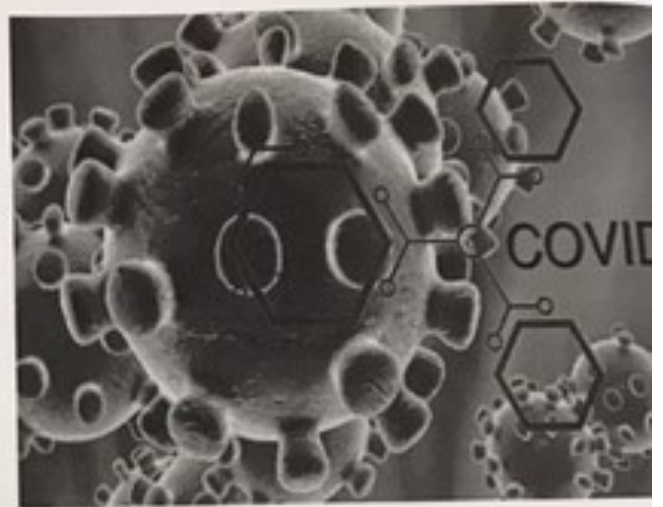


HERE WE GO AGAIN
