Some children come in to school as their parents are key workers that means that they can't be at home with their children/child ads they have to work.

In Upham the teaches have had a bit of an upgrade in technology as they do teams /zoom meetings last lockdown they didn't have teams meetings. There are about 20 children in school at the moment and years R, 1 and 2 all are in the same class room and years 3, 4, 5 and 6 are all in one class room. It is very different this term but I think everyone is just about hanging on to how the new way of learning.
