



Find and Sink Initial /sw/ Sound Game

Overview

This activity is designed for children who can articulate /sw/ consistently at the beginning of words (single word level). It allows children to practise using /sw/ at the beginning of words at sentence level.

The adult working with the children provides feedback if a child says the wrong sound at the beginning of the word. The adult models the correct sound, slightly emphasising the sound at the beginning of the word.

Instructions

Each player is given a copy of the sheet below.

Each player puts one tick in one of the boxes on the sheet, being careful not to let the other player see where their tick is placed.

Player one asks player two where the tick is. For example, 'Is your tick on swimming four?' or 'Is your tick on sweater two?' If player one chooses a space where there is no tick, player two places a cross on that space and says to player one, 'no it is not on swimming four.' It is then the other player's turn to ask where the tick is.

The winner is the first player to select the space with the tick.
