

Mayan Warrior

YOU WILL NEED:

A4 paper

Drawing pencil/rubber

Colouring pens/pencils/paints

1. Sit somewhere with good light, preferably near a window.
2. You may already have an idea of what your warrior will look like - brilliant. If not, google a few ideas.
3. Start by sketching out in pencil with a rough outline and a few details.
4. When you start to colour in, think about using different shades. Remember, the Mayans liked oranges, reds and browns - earthy colours. They took their colours from nature so greens and blues were used as well.



5. I chose a warrior who wore feathers because I liked the idea of a large headdress which would make him look taller and therefore more scary!
6. Have some fun with this and don't forget, Mayans liked big noses so make sure your warrior has a prominent proboscis.
