Four Directions of the World

Sak Xib Chaac, the white Chaac of the north

Ex Xib Chaac, the black Chaac of the west

Kan Xib Chaac, the Yellow Chaac of the south

For the ancient Mayans the rain God had a particularly strong relationship with the rulers, because for the earlier periods of Mayan history ruler were conceded as rainmakers.
