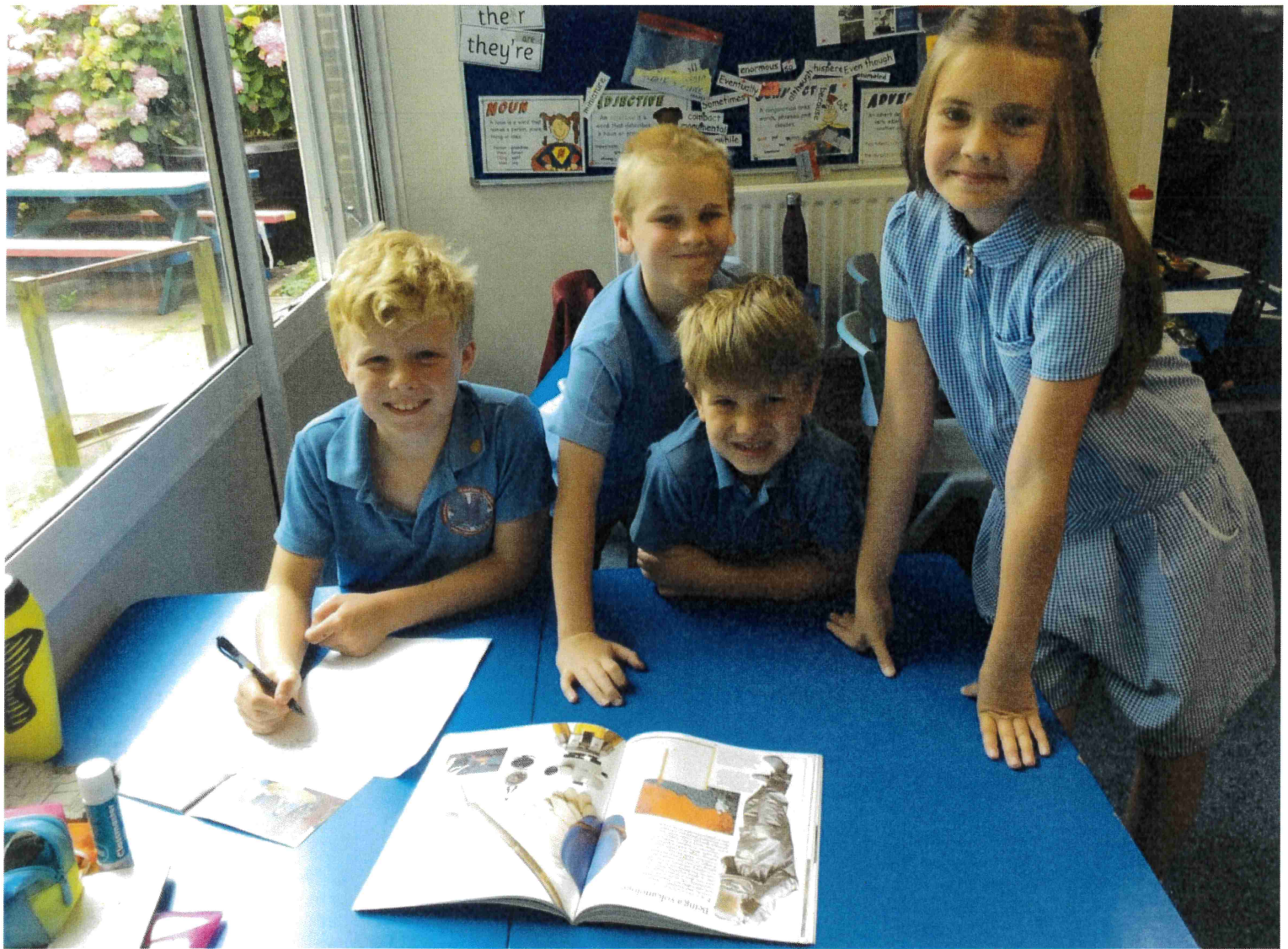

In art we make things, draw, create, and design things. Sometimes we do cooking and baking.

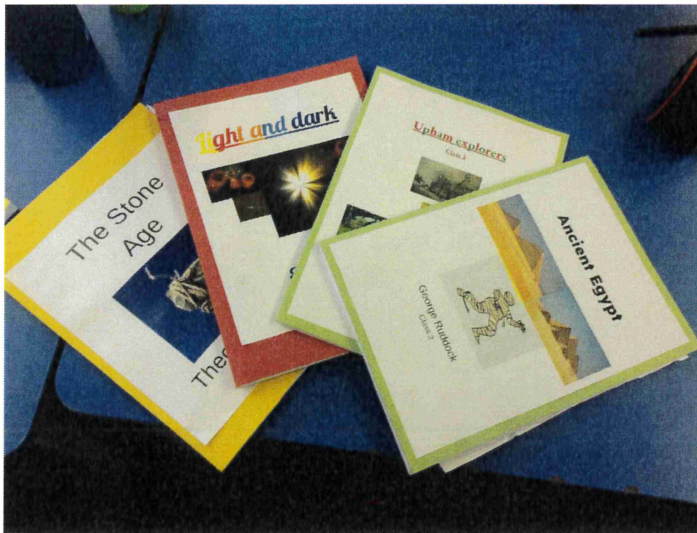
In music we learn: recorder, ukulele, flute, guitar, african drums, samba drums and african percussion. Our music teacher is called Mr Munday.

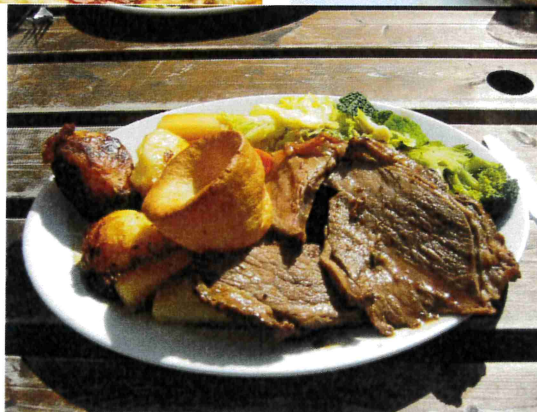

Every year, every class goes on 2 or 3 school Trips to learn new things about their topic and be knowledgeable!

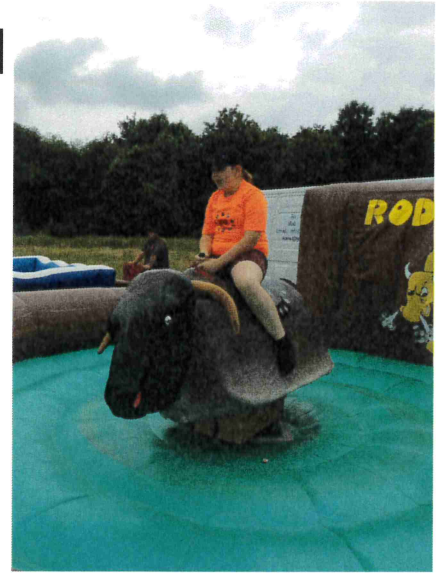

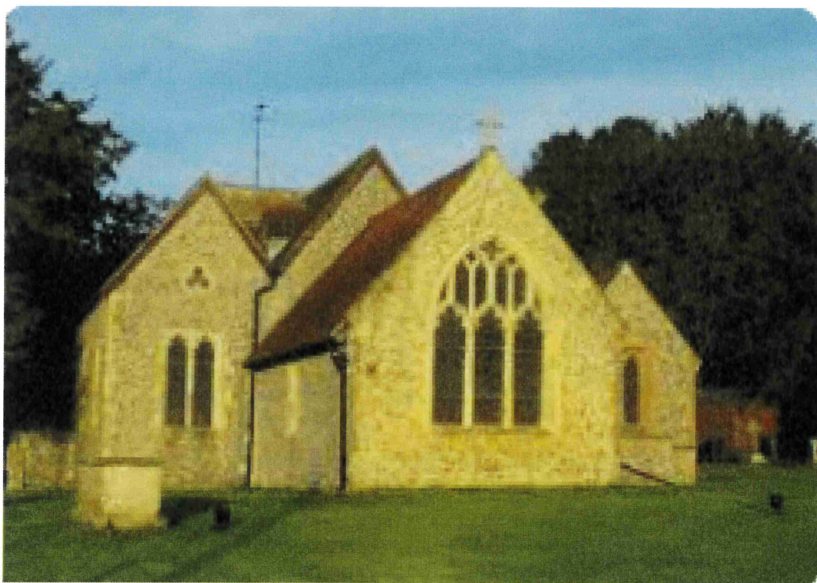
# Buddies
