#### Things we discussed – Findings from Uniform surveys in each class

##### Is your uniform comfortable to wear?

School councillors said most people said the uniform was comfortable.

Some class 4s said 'It is comfortable. I prefer the logo. The clothes are a little too tight. The jumpers are itchy. Non-logo shirts are comfortable. Dresses are too tight.' Class 2 had voted and 8 said no and said the tops are not comfy and the logo rubs, 22 said yes.

##### Are they warm enough/ cool enough?

51 Too hot                      30 in Class 2 though they were too hot

35 OK

5 Too cold

##### Do they fit OK?

19 Do you ever have tight collars?

17 Do you ever have tight cuffs?

Some Class 1 children said the head holes are too small. Some Class 4 councillors said that they remember this but as they went through the school this was less of a problem.

A few people described the logo backing rubbing and being itchy.

##### Which Logo do you think should be on the front?

Children 'voted for the logo they thought was best



21 children



42 children. 21 of these were from Class 4, school councillor thought it was because the pink colour made it popular

##### What do you think of our PE kit?

Class 1 children said 'Jumpers are a bit hard to put on and take off. Class 3s said 12 liked and 4 didn't like. Class 4 children said 'Too hot. It is comfortable. I don't like the logo. The back of the T-shirt is uncomfortable. Neck holes too small. The logo rubs against chest.'

School councillors discussed that lots of people mentioned that the label in the back of the T-shirt at the top rubs – lots of parents have had to cut them out. We also thought having a logo on a track suit bottom would be good.

##### If you have been on a school sport completion what did you wear?

39 PE kit

13 my own cloths

37 School kit

Class 4 children said 'Football kit shorts are itchy. It should be optional. Barely ever allowed to wear own clothes to school tournaments.'

Class 4 councillors also said that when people did say they wore their own clothes this was mainly swimming kit to swimming galas.
