

Extreme Sports



This term Badger class will engage in the topic 'Extreme Sports'. The focus will be on science, learning about what forces are and how they work. The children will carry out many investigations to explore this further. They will find out about a range of extreme sports and consider how different forces play a part in each.



In English this term the children will be reading a range of non-fiction texts about forces and sports. They will talk about the importance of carefully organising and presenting information in non-fiction and use this to guide them when writing their own non-fiction texts. They will also learn about how author's build tension and write their own suspense extreme sports stories.



In maths this half term, we will be focusing on: symbols, multiplication, scale and fractions linked to ratio; place value, rounding, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division linked to decimals and investigate connections between fractions, decimals and percentages.

Additionally, we will be engaging in worded problems and reasoning tasks around these topics to deepen our understanding.

Home Help—How can you support your child with this half term's learning?

Please encourage and support your child to research this topic further at home. The homework grid sent out today is focused on this topic and will give you a starting point. The children have been asked to complete five (Y5) or three (Y6) activities this half term.
