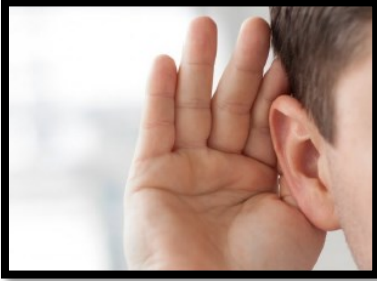


Sound of Music!



This term Badger Class will be immersing themselves in our 'Sound of Music topic.' We will be focussing on sound, looking at how sounds are made, how we hear sounds and why some sounds are louder and quieter or higher and lower. Additionally, we will also be looking at how different musical instruments make sounds and the type of sounds they produce. The children will be composing a piece of music to accompany the Easter Story which they will perform.



In English sessions, the children will be continuing to explore the story of Jemmy Button (written by Valerio Viidali) by writing a newspaper article and balanced argument. They will go on to study the story of The Happy Prince, a tale by Oscar Wilde Maisie where the children will be writing an important persuasive email to the council.



In Maths, the children will be continuing with their work on fractions, decimals and percentage knowledge and skills. Along side this they will also be investigating area, perimeter and volume, algebra and statistics.

Home Help—How can you support your child with this half term's learning?

Please encourage and support your child to research this topic further at home. The homework grid sent out today is focused on this topic and will give you a starting point. The children have been asked to complete five (Y5) or three (Y6) activities this half term. Primarily, the Year 6 children should complete their weekly SATs revision homework first. We are extremely proud of the effort all the Year children have been making so far.

Please continue to help your child to learn their spellings for their test every Friday and also continue to encourage your child to read regularly at home and practise their times tables.
