Longdown Activity Farm – Thursday 1st May 2025

On Thursday 1st May, Class 1 will be visiting Longdown Activity Farm in Ashurst. This will be an exciting opportunity for the children to get hands on experience with farm animals in a farm environment.

We will be travelling to and from the farm by coach, departing and returning within normal school times. Children will need to wear their school jumper and trousers/leggings with sturdy footwear and a waterproof coat or if it is going to be hot with a sunhat and sun lotion (to be applied before they come to school). They will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle, carried in a named bag. If you would like school to provide a cold picnic lunch for your child, please indicate on the slip below.

We would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of £27.50 per child (*includes transport costs of £18.30*) towards the cost of the trip. The system has been set-up to allow parents to pay in installments should you prefer.

Although we are legally required to refer to the cost as 'voluntary', the reality is that if we do not receive contributions from parents we cannot provide these valuable learning opportunities and experiences. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip is unlikely to go ahead.
